## Associate in Insurance (AINS)/The Institutes

## \*recommended

AINS is for anyone new to risk management and insurance. This includes someone just starting to work professionally or who has recently changed careers. Apprentices must take four courses and pass their respective exams through the Institutes, which may be credited towards future designations. Exam candidates may purchase the exams only, or purchase preparation courses in addition to the exam youchers.

## Associate in Claims (AIC)/The Institutes

In order to earn the AIC designation, you must pass two foundation courses in addition to completing all of the courses listed in a specialty track (Auto, Liability, Property, Workers Compensation), and one Ethics exam. Each course exam contains three sub-exams, and requires 4-6 weeks for preparation.
